Freedom of Information request

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received 5th February.

In your request you asked for the following information

- *'Copy of the inspectorate's latest report on the performance of the Crown Prosecution Service'*

We do not hold the information within the scope of this request.

By way of background- Her Majesty's Crown Prosecution Service Inspectorate (HMCPsi) inspects the work carried out by the Crown Prosecution Service (CPS). The purpose of our work is to enhance the quality of justice and make an assessment of prosecution services that enables or leads to improvement in their efficiency effectiveness and fairness. However, our reports do not report on the overall performance of CPS but looks at specific elements of their work.

The most recent report published is "Evidence led domestic abuse prosecutions" was a joint inspection with the HM Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services (HMICFRS). This report was published on 23rd January 2020.
